INVITATION TO BID FOR SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF TESTING (LAB/FIELD) AND CALIBRATION EQUIPMENT FOOD (GRAINS/LEGUMES/SUGAR, (PPES), (SANITIZERS) AND LAPTOPS AND RUGGED LAPTOP COMPUTERS

1. Private Sector Foundation Uganda (PSFU) in partnership with Mastercard Foundation has put in place a Recovery and Resilience Fund to support micro, small, and medium sized enterprises (MSMEs) during the economic downturn caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. PSFU is the umbrella body for the private sector made up of 250 Business Associations, Corporate bodies and Public Sector Agencies that support private sector growth.
2. Private Sector Foundation Uganda now invites bids from eligible bidders for supply and delivery of the following:

Lot 1: Supply and delivery of (2) Grain Moisture Meters (Laboratory), (1) NIR Spectrometer Equipment for rapid Grain Testing, (3) Digital Hot Plate for grain testing, (4) Heating mantles for grain testing, (2) Automatic colony counters, (1) Automated culture media dispenser, (1) 850 litres Incubator, (1) Saccharimeter for Pol, determination in Sugar, (11) Aflatoxin Reader and kits (Certification and Surveillance field activities), (11) Portable Moisture Meters (Certification and Surveillance field activities) and (1) Grain moisture meter analyser (Calibration)

Lot 2: Supply and delivery of (1) UTM Equipment for PPE Testing and (1) Washing Machine equipment for Mask testing Kits.

Lot 3: Supply and delivery of (1) Meter for Alcohol content determination for various matrices (Laboratory), (14) Portable Alcohol content Meters (Certification/Surveillance field activities) and (13) Portable pH Meter (Certification/Surveillance field activities)

Lot 4: Supply and delivery of (32) Laptops and (4) rugged laptop computers

3. Bidding will be conducted through the **Open Domestic Bidding/Tendering** procedures as

specified in the PSFU Procurement Policies and Procedures Manual

Qualification requirements include: (a) minimum average annual turnover of at least twice the bid price in the last three (3) years; (b) Evidence of a minimum of three (3) contracts of similar scope and value in the last three (3) years supported by copies of delivery notes and certificates of acceptance and/or good performance from the previous clients; (c) Availability of after sales services.
7. Bids must be submitted electronically by 1500 hrs, on November 10th, 2020. Late bids will be rejected.
