Private Sector Foundation Uganda's 9th Private Sector Development

Awards are here again. These awards recognize impactful

- Business Associations/Cooperatives that demonstrate; good governance, outstanding efforts in representing member interests, member activities, service delivery, financial management and information sharing to benefit their members.
- Companies that are investing in social causes to improve the welfare of the society they are working in.
- Government Agencies that are working to improve the private sector through implementing services that support entrepreneurs and businesses to start/grow/thrive.
- To participate, download, complete and submit your nomination form for the awards and stand a chance of winning in the following categories:

A) BUSINESS ASSOCIATION OF THE YEAR

A.1: Business Association of the Year - National Level

This award recognizes a business Association, or member based organization that has a National presence. With a well-established secretariat, good governance structures, audited accounts and has been in existence for more than three years with recognizable achievement in membership development, policy research and advocacy and sustainable revenue sources. This category is eligible to only PSFU members.

A.2: Business Association of the Year-Regional Level

This award recognizes a member based organization operating at the

local level (district, regional etc.) focusing on services that have resulted in economic empowerment of communities. Only formal groups, and registered cooperative societies that have been in existence for at least three years are eligible to participate in this category.

B) PRIVATE SECTOR CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY (CSR) CHAMPION OF THE YEAR

B.1: Environment Social And Governance (ESG) Champion

This award recognizes a Business Membership Organization or a Company that through its ESG program has continually promoted and improved the welfare of communities it works in. Only Business Membership Organizations and Corporate companies that have been in existence for more than three years will be eligible for this category.

B.2: Community Development Champion

This award recognizes innovative, engaged and successful community development project/initiative that has influenced the community and impacted people's wellbeing sustainably. The award is open to any community development project/initiative. Companies, Business Membership Organizations, Projects/Programs, INGOs & NGOs are eligible for this Award.

C) WOMAN ORGANIZATION OF THE YEAR.

This award recognizes an organization founded or 51% owned by women. The Award seeks to recognize a woman owned organization/business that has achieved notable success in its area of operation and its achievements must be impressive enough to inspire many women entrepreneurs who are looking for a role model.

D) YOUTH ORGANIZATION OF THE YEAR.

This award recognizes an organization (company or business membership organization) founded or 51% owned by a young person (18-35 years). The Award seeks to recognize a youth owned organization/business that has

achieved notable success in its area of operation and its achievements must be impactful enough to inspire many young entrepreneurs who are looking for a role model.

E) PRIVATE SECTOR MEDIA PERSONALITY OF THE YEAR.

This award seeks to recognize published, and broadcast works in 2024 in the form of print, online radio, and television whose work has had an impact to the private sector development in Uganda. The award is open to individual media personalities only and not media institutions or organizations.

F) GOVERNMENT AGENCY OF THE YEAR

This award recognizes a Government Agency that has supported private sector/business growth and development in Uganda. The award also recognizes a Government Agency that has improved efficiency in service delivery, developed innovative services/products that respond to the needs of the private sector in Uganda.
